Subtitle of House Bill No. 1598

"AN ACT TO PROVIDE PENALTIES FOR VIOLATING THE STATE ELECTRICAL CODE
AND THE PROVISIONS CONCERNING THE EXAMINATION AND LICENSING OF
ELECTRICIANS."

Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 1598.

Amend House Bill No. 1598 as originally introduced:

Add Representative Childers as a cosponsor of the bill

AND

Page 1, delete lines 25 through 28 and substitute the following:

"SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 17-28-309 is amended to read as follows:

~~(a) Any person who performs electrical work in the state without an exemption or the required license pursuant to the provisions of this chapter, or who otherwise violates any provisions of this chapter, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be punished by a fine of not less than fifty dollars (\$50.00) and not more than five hundred dollars (\$500) or by imprisonment for not more than thirty (30) days, or both fine and imprisonment. Each day during which a violation continues shall be a separate offense.~~

~~(b)(a) In addition to the penalties in subsection (a) of this section, the The Director of the Department of Labor is authorized to petition any court of competent jurisdiction to enjoin or restrain any person who performs electrical work without a license, or who otherwise violates the provisions of this chapter.~~

(b)(1) A civil penalty may be assessed by the Board of Electrical"
