Subtitle of House Bill No. 2236 "AN ACT TO IMPROVE THE QUALITY OF CARE IN LONG-TERM CARE FACILITIES." Amendment No. 2 to House Bill No. 2236. Amend House Bill No. 2236 as originally introduced: Page 2, delete lines 13 through 27 and substitute the following: "(a) All long-term care facilities eligible to receive Medicaid reimbursement shall require all nurse aides to: (1) Complete two (2) hours of orientation, which shall be specific to the facility in which the nurse aide is employed, and including the Heimlich maneuver; and (2) Satisfy one (1) of the following: (A) Complete a state-approved training and competency evaluation program; or (B) Demonstrate competence through satisfactory participation in a state-approved nurses aide training and competency evaluation program that includes at least sixteen (16) hours of training in the following subjects before any direct contact with the resident: (i) Communication and interpersonal skills; (ii) Infection control; (iii) Safety and emergency procedures; (iv) Promoting residents' independence; and (v) Respecting residents' rights. (b) The provisions of subsection (a) shall not apply to nurse aides from an employment agency who are working at the facility in a temporary capacity."
