Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 2315.
Amend House Bill No. 2315 as originally introduced:
Page 1, delete lines 9 through 11 and substitute the following: "AN ACT TO ALLOW TESTATORS TO WAIVE THE SURETY BOND REQUIREMENT FOR"
AND
Page 2, delete lines 6 through 8 and substitute the following: "(2) For wills or codicils executed on or after the effective date of this act, a testator may direct or request in his or her will or codicil that no bond will be required of his or her personal"
AND
Page 2, line 11 delete "not take" and substitute "be deprived of"
AND
Page 2, delete lines 22 through 23 and substitute the following: "(2) For wills or codicils executed on or after the effective date of this act, the court may not dispense with the"
AND
Page 2, line 26 insert the following: "(3) This section does not affect any claims or causes of action
that a devisee may have against a personal representative for depletion of the estate in an unauthorized or unlawful manner."
