**Amendment No. 2 to House Bill No. 2417.**

Amend House Bill No. 2417 as originally introduced:

Page 3, line 26, after "the" and before "ballot" insert "runoff general election"

AND

Page 4, line 1, after "~~(B)~~" and before "(2)" delete "(d)"

AND

Page 6, delete lines 27-29

AND

Page 8, delete lines 1 through 12

AND

Page 8 line 14, delete "12" and substitute "10"

AND

Page 8, delete lines 30 through 26

AND

Page 9, delete lines 1 through 5

AND

Page 9, line 6, delete "~~(b)~~(c)" and substitute "(b)"

AND



Page 10, line 18, delete "~~(e)~~(d)" and substitute "(c)"

AND

Page 10, line 33, delete "~~(d)~~(e)" and substitute "(d)"

AND

Page 10, delete line 36 and substitute the following:

"(e)(1) The governing body of any city of the first class, city of the"

AND

Page 11, delete lines 1 through 8 and substitute the following:

"second class, or incorporated town may enact an ordinance requiring independent candidates for municipal office to file petitions for nomination as independent candidates with the county clerk no later than noon on the day before the preferential primary election.

(2) The ordinance shall be enacted no later than ninety (90) days prior to the filing deadline. The ordinance shall be published at least once a week for two (2) consecutive weeks immediately following adoption of the ordinance in a newspaper having a general circulation in the city."
