Subtitle of House Bill No. 2825

"AN ACT TO AMEND THE PROCESS FOR APPEALS FROM AN ORDER BY THE
PROFESSIONAL BAIL BOND COMPANY AND PROFESSIONAL BAIL BONDSMAN
LICENSING BOARD."

Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 2825.

Amend House Bill No. 2825 as originally introduced:

Page 2, line 3 add the following new section:

"SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that an appeal from an order by the
Professional Bail Bond Company and Professional Bail Bondsman Licensing Board
to the County Circuit of Pulaski County operates as a stay which may cause an
injustice to occur; that the stay shouldn't be automatic, but rather after a
hearing. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act being
immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and
safety shall become effective on:

(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;

(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,
the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the
bill; or

(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto."
