**Subtitle of House Joint Resolution No. 1017**

**Amendment No. 1 to House Joint Resolution No. 1017.**

Amend House Joint Resolution No. 1017 as originally introduced:

Page 2, delete lines 11 through 20, and substitute the following:  
"prizes, without any appropriation required by law, and to supplement, not supplant, appropriations provided by the General Assembly for educational programs and educational purposes, and for a trust fund as provided by this amendment and the General Assembly.

(3) The proceeds after payment of the operating expenses shall be separately accounted for and divided as follows:

(A)(i) Fifty percent (50%) shall be deposited into and held in a trust fund entitled "Education Trust Fund" together with any interest accumulated on the funds until the Education Trust Fund has a balance equal to or exceeding one hundred million dollars (\$100,000,000);

(ii) Any amount in Education Trust Fund balance exceeding one hundred million dollars (\$100,000,000) may be subject to appropriation by the General Assembly solely for educational programs and educational purposes; and

(B) Fifty percent (50%) shall be specifically identified as a separate budget category entitled "Lottery Proceeds", and subject to appropriation by the General Assembly solely for educational programs and educational purposes.
