L. No. 101-644, and the Indian Arts and Crafts Enforcement Act of 2000, Pub. L. No. 106-497 for Northern Cherokee artists,"

AND

Page 2, line 10, delete "tribe." and substitute "tribe, for the purpose of expanding opportunities for economic development for Native Americans, providing access to scholarships for Native American youth, and providing access to federal programs under the Indian Arts and Crafts Act of 1990, Pub. L. No. 101-644, and the Indian Arts and Crafts Enforcement Act of 2000, Pub. L. No. 106-497 for Northern Cherokee artists."
