Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill No. 116.

Amend Senate Bill No. 116 as originally introduced:

Page 2, line 12 add the following

"(b) Notwithstanding the requirements set forth in § 17-102-304, any acupuncturist who holds a valid license to practice acupuncture issued by another state as of the effective date of this section, shall upon application to the Arkansas State Board of Acupuncture and Related Techniques be issued a license without an examination."
