Amendment No. 2 to Senate Bill No. 202.

Amend Senate Bill No. 202 as engrossed, 03/18/03:

Page 1, line 12, delete "WHICH SHALL" and substitute "; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

And

Page 1, delete line 13, 14 and 15 in their entirety

And

Page 1, line 21, delete "SUPPLEMENTAL" and substitute "GENERAL IMPROVEMENT"

And

Page 1, line 29, delete "University of Arkansas at Monticello Fund" and substitute "General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts"

And

Page 1, line 30, delete "support" and substitute "support and reimbursement of Fiscal Year 2003 expenditures"

And

Page 1, delete lines 31 and 32 in their entirety and substitute the following:

"University of Arkansas at Monticello, the"

And

Page 1, line 36, delete "2002-2003" and substitute "2003-2004"

And



Page 2, line 2, delete "\$375,000" and substitute "\$450,000"

And

Delete Section 2 in its entirety

And

Delete Section 5 in its entirety and substitute the following:

" SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2003 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2003 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2003."

And

Appropriately renumber the sections of the bill.
