Subtitle of Senate Bill No. 228

"AN ACT TO MAKE KNOWINGLY BUYING OR SELLING A VEHICLE WITHOUT A
MANUFACTURER'S SERIAL NUMBER OR ENGINE NUMBER A CLASS C FELONY."

Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill No. 228.

Amend Senate Bill No. 228 as originally introduced:

Delete everything after the enacting clause and substitute the following:

"SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-14-2210 is amended to read as follows:
27-14-2210. Vehicles or engines without manufacturers' numbers.

(a) Any person who knowingly buys, receives, disposes of, sells, offers for sale, or has in his possession any motor vehicle or engine removed from a motor vehicle, from which the manufacturer's serial or engine number or other distinguishing number or identification mark or number placed thereon under assignment from the office has been removed, defaced, covered, altered, or destroyed, for the purpose of concealing or misrepresenting the identity of the motor vehicle or engine, is guilty of a ~~misdemeanor~~ Class D felony.

(b) Any person who pleads guilty or nolo contendere to, or is found guilty of a second or subsequent offense shall be guilty of a Class C felony."
