Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill No. 35.
Amend Senate Bill No. 35 as originally introduced:
Page 2, delete line 5, and substitute the following:  "(4) "Parent-teacher conference" means a meeting regularly"
AND
Page 2, delete line 14 and substitute the following:  "no less than three (3) hours.  (4) No less than ten (10) calendar days prior to the taking of leave to attend a parent-teacher conference, the employee shall provide written notification of his or her intent to his or her immediate supervisor or other appropriate person necessary to obtain leave authorization.  (5) Upon request by the parent, the school district shall provide written verification of the parent's attendance at the parent-teacher conference, which shall include the name of the parent, the date of the parent-teacher conference, the time of the parent-teacher conference, and a statement confirming the employee's attendance.
