Amend Senate Bill No. 742 as originally introduced:
Page 2, line 14, insert the following:
"SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that certain records of law abiding
citizens of this state need further protection from disclosure; that this act
provides that protection; and that until this act goes into effect, the law
abiding citizens of this state will remain in danger of information being disclosed which is contrary to their best interests. Therefore, an emergency
is declared to exist, and this act being immediately necessary for the
preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become effective
on:
(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,
the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the
bill; or
(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto."
