"AN ACT TO ALLOW ARTICLE III FEDERAL JUDGES AND OTHER ARKANSAS BASED
FEDERAL JUDICIAL OFFICERS TO CARRY CONCEALED HANDGUNS. "

Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill No. 76.

Amend Senate Bill No. 76 as originally introduced:

Page 1, line 26 add "after making written certification to the Chief Judge of the U. S. District Court in the Federal Judicial District in which they serve that they have taken a handgun safety training course approved by the Director, Arkansas Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and Training" after "handgun" and before ".""

AND

Page 1, line 35 add "and has made written certification to the Chief Judge of the U. S. District Court in the Federal Judicial District in which they serve that they have taken a handgun safety training course approved by the Director, Arkansas Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and Training" after "Arkansas" and before ".""

AND

Page 2, line 7 add "and has made written certification to the Chief Judge of the U. S. District Court in the Federal Judicial District in which they serve that they have taken a handgun safety training course approved by the Director, Arkansas Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and Training" after "Arkansas" and before ".""

AND

Page 2, line 9 add the following new section:

"SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 5-73-304, concerning exemptions form the concealed handgun licensing law, is amended by adding the following new subsection:

(d) Those persons vested by Article III of the Constitution of the United States with the judicial power of the United States, Article III Federal Judges, and those persons appointed and serving as United States Bankruptcy Judges or United States Magistrate Judges in and for the Eastern



or Western Districts of Arkansas who have made written certification to the Chief Judge of the U. S. District Court in the Federal Judicial District in which they serve that they have taken a handgun safety training course approved by the Director, Arkansas Commission on Law Enforcement Standards and Training shall be exempt from the licensing requirements of this subchapter.”
