Subtitle of Senate Bill No. 940

"AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND TOURISM TO DEVELOP A
COMPREHENSIVE PLAN TO FOCUS ON MINORITY TOURISM."

Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill No. 940.

Amend Senate Bill No. 940 as originally introduced:

Delete everything after the Enacting clause and substitute the following:

"SECTION 1. (a) The Director of the Department of Parks and Tourism shall develop a comprehensive plan to focus on minority tourism.

(b) The plan shall recognize and publicize, within and without the state:

(1) The current size of the state's minority population, including:

(A) An African-American population exceeding four hundred eighteen thousand (418,000) persons, constituting fifteen and seven tenths percent (15.7%) of the state's population; and

(B) A Hispanic population approaching eighty-seven thousand (87,000) persons, constituting three and two tenths percent (3.2%) of the state's population; and

(2) Sites and events of special interest in to minorities."
