Amendment No. 1 to Senate Joint Resolution No. 5.

Amend Senate Joint Resolution No. 5 as originally introduced:

Add Senators Womack, Baker, Laverty as cosponsors of the resolution

AND

Page 2, delete lines 18 through 20 and substitute the following:

"(a)(1) The regular biennial sessions <u>held during odd numbered years</u> shall not exceed sixty (60) <u>legislative</u> days in duration <u>during a period of</u> <u>eighty-five (85) calendar days</u>, unless by a vote of two-thirds of the members elected to each house of said <u>the</u> General Assembly <u>the number of legislative</u> days, calendar days, or both are extended.

(2) A legislative day is a calendar day when either house of the General Assembly is in session."

Page 2, line 22, delete "calendar" and substitute "legislative"
