Subtitle of Senate Joint Resolution No. 5

"PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE ARKANSAS CONSTITUTION TO PROVIDE
FOR ANNUAL SESSIONS OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY AND TO AUTHORIZE
SPECIAL SESSIONS OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY AS MAY BE PROVIDED BY LAW."

Amendment No. 2 to Senate Joint Resolution No. 5.

Amend Senate Joint Resolution No. 5 as engrossed, 03/12/03:

Page 1, line 12, delete "SPECIAL" and substitute "EXTRAORDINARY"

AND

Page 1, line 20, delete "SPECIAL" and substitute "EXTRAORDINARY"

AND

Page 2, delete line 6, and substitute the following:

"(b)(1) The General Assembly may consider any issue within the legislative authority of the General Assembly during the regular session held in odd numbered years, including, but not limited to, bills enacting new laws, bills amending, revising, and changing present laws, bills appropriating funds, bills restricting the use of funds, bills raising or decreasing revenues, bills of an emergency nature, certifying the results of the general elections, proposing amendments to the Arkansas Constitution, confirming appointments made by the Governor, and impeachments.

(2) Only bills restricting the use of"

AND

Page 2, delete line 11, and substitute the following:

"(c) In addition to extraordinary sessions called by the Governor, extraordinary"

AND

Page 2, delete lines 26 and 27 , and substitute the following:

"exceed thirty (30) legislative days in duration during a period of sixty (60) calendar days, unless by a vote of two-thirds of the members elected to



each house of the General Assembly the number of legislative days, calendar days, or both are extended.”
