Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill No. 35.
Amend Senate Bill No. 35 as originally introduced:
Delete SECTION 1. of the bill and substitute the following: "SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-13-1406(a), concerning annexation of
school districts, is amended to read as follows: (a)(l)(A) Unless the board of directors of the affected district or
districts and the board of directors of the receiving district or districts
agree otherwise, the board of directors of the receiving district or
districts after annexation shall be the same board of directors of the
receiving district prior to annexation until the next regular school election.
(B)(i) In lieu of electing a new board of directors at the
next regular school election, the board of directors of the affected district
or districts and the board of directors of the receiving district may agree
to form an interim board whose members shall serve until the regular school
election in the year following the effective date of the annexation.
(ii)(a) If an interim board is formed to serve until
the school election in the year following the effective date of the annexation, the interim board shall be composed of the members of the board
of directors of the receiving district and at least one (1) member selected
by the board of directors of each affected district.
(b) Each member selected from the affected
district shall be determined by a vote of the affected board. In the case of
a tie vote the member shall be selected by drawing lots."
