Amendment No. 4 to Senate Bill No. 55. Amend Senate Bill No. 55 as originally introduced: Add a new section immediately following Section 2 to read as follows:

SECTION 3. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CHILDHOOD SPECIAL EDUCATION. If no less than forty million dollars (\$40,000,000) is allocated for the Arkansas Better Chance for School Success Program, then up to one million two-hundred thousand dollars (\$1,200,000) may be set-aside to supplement Early Childhood Special Education Services provided by the Arkansas Department of Education. Receipt of monies set-aside for Early Childhood Special Education Services in no way precludes local school districts from qualifying for additional funds for special education programs available through the Arkansas Better Chance for School Success Program."
