"AN ACT TO REVISE THE MINIMUM WAGE ACT OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS."

Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill No. 11.

Amend Senate Bill No. 11 as originally introduced:

Delete line 23 page 8 and substitute the following:

"SECTION 7. Arkansas Code § 11-4-212(a), concerning the allowance for gratuities, is amended to read as follows:

(a) Every employer of an employee engaged in any occupation in which gratuities have been customarily and usually constituted and have been recognized as a part of remuneration for hiring purposes shall be entitled to an allowance for gratuities as a part of the hourly wage rate provided in § 11-4-210 in an amount not to exceed fifty percent (50%) forty-two percent (42%) of the minimum wage established by § 11-4-210, provided that the employee actually received that amount in gratuities and that the application of the foregoing gratuity allowances results in payment of wages other than gratuities to tipped employees, including full-time students subject to the provisions of § 11-4-210, of no less than fifty percent (50%) forty-two percent (42%) of the minimum wage prescribed by § 11-4-210.

SECTION 8. This act shall become effective on October 1, 2006."
