## Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill No. 27.


Amend Senate Bill No. 27 as originally introduced:

Delete Section 2 entirely and substitute the following: "SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 6-17-2403(b) and (c), concerning the minimum teacher compensation schedule, is amended to read as follows: (b)(1) In school years year 2004-2005 and 2005-2006, each school district in the state shall have in place a salary schedule with at least the following minimum levels of compensation for a basic contract:
