Amend Senate Bill No. 239 as engrossed, S2/22/07 (version: 02-22-2007 11:39):

Page 2, delete lines 27 through 36, and substitute the following: "purpose of § 16-34-106, any person whose name appears on any legal and authorized grand jury or petit jury list of the respective counties of Arkansas shall receive in addition to any other fees allowable by law the following per diem compensation:

- (1) When the person fails for any reason to attend court, no per diem compensation;
- (2) When the person attends court and is excused by the court for any reason from serving as a juror, a minimum of per diem compensation of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00); and
- (3) When the person has been sworn touching his or her qualifications to serve as a juror and has been accepted by the court as qualified, a minimum of per diem compensation of forty dollars (\$40.00) per day."


Delete SECTION 3 in its entirety

Page 3, delete lines 34 and 35, and substitute the following: "diem compensation under § 16-34-103(b) shall be paid promptly to each juror or prospective juror by a"
