## Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 2151.

Amend House Bill No. 2151 as originally introduced:

Page 1, delete lines 21 through 24 and substitute:

"SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 3-3-202(a), concerning knowingly furnishing or selling alcoholic beverages to a minor, is amended to read as follows:

(a)(1) It shall be unlawful for any person knowingly to give, procure, or otherwise furnish any alcoholic beverage to any person under twenty-one (21) years of age. However, this section shall not apply to the serving of such to one's family or to the use of wine <u>or beer</u> in any religious ceremony or rite in any established church or religion."
