### Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 2151.

Amend House Bill No. 2151 as originally introduced:

Page 1, delete lines 21 through 24 and substitute:

"SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 3-3-202(a), concerning knowingly  
furnishing or selling alcoholic beverages to a minor, is amended to read as  
follows:

(a)(1) It shall be unlawful for any person knowingly to give, procure,  
or otherwise furnish any alcoholic beverage to any person under twenty-one  
(21) years of age. However, this section shall not apply to the serving of  
such to one's family or to the use of wine or beer in any religious ceremony  
or rite in any established church or religion."
