## Amendment No. 2 to Senate Bill No. 108.

Amend Senate Bill No. 108 as engrossed, S1/28/09 (version: 01-28-2009 09:01):

Page 1, line 22, add a new section as follows: "SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-17-2602 is amended to read as follows: 6-17-2602. Definitions. As used in this subchapter: (1) "Educational setting" means the employment setting where the certified licensed employee works, including without limitation: (A) A public or private school; (B) An institution of higher education; (C) An education service cooperative; (D) The Department of Education; (E) An adult education setting; or (F) Another agency or organization that employs licensed teachers for educational purposes; (2) "Professional development" means a coordinated set of planned, learning development activities for teachers that are standardsbased and that meet the focus areas for professional development required by the department; and "Teaching experience" means the experience gained while (3)

working in an educational setting as a teacher, librarian, counselor, administrator, educational consultant, substitute teacher, or other <del>certified</del> <u>licensed</u> employee."

AND

Page 1, line 25, delete "certified" and substitute "certified licensed"

AND

Appropriately renumber the sections of the bill.
