Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 1958 Amend House Bill No. 1958 as originally introduced: Delete Section 1 and substitute: "SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 5-73-306(16), regarding the prohibition against carrying a concealed handgun in a church or other place of worship, is amended to read as follows: (16)(A) Any church or other place of worship, if the church or other place of worship has a sign affixed to its entrance expressly prohibiting the carrying of a concealed handgun inside the church or other place of worship. (B)(i) A church or other place of worship also may allow only a specified group of licensees, such as certified law enforcement officers, to carry a concealed handgun inside the church or other place of worship, as denoted on a sign posted at the entrance to the church or other place of worship. (ii) Subdivision (16)(B)(i) of this section does not prohibit a church or other place of worship from exercising discretion in deciding which licensees are permitted to carry a concealed handgun inside the church or other place of worship;"
