Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill No. 1004

Amend Senate Bill No. 1004 as originally introduced:

Delete everything after the enacting clause and substitute the following: "SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 20-27-1903 is amended to read as follows: 20-27-1903. Tobacco use - Prohibitions.

Effective July 21, 2006, smoking <u>Smoking</u> is prohibited in any motor vehicle in which a child who is less than six (6) <u>fourteen (14)</u> years of age and who weighs less than sixty pounds (60 lbs.) is restrained in a child passenger safety seat properly secured to the motor vehicle in accordance with The Child Passenger Protection Act, § 27-34-101 et seq is a passenger."
