AN ACT TO PROTECT THE PUBLIC HEALTH BY REGULATING THE PRIVATE
OWNERSHIP OF NONHUMAN PRIMATES.

Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill No. 901

Amend Senate Bill No. 901 as engrossed, S3/23/11 (version: 03/23/2011 05:03:13 PM)

Page 4, line 13, delete "(i)" and substitute "(i)(1)"

AND

Page 4, delete line 14 and substitute the following:

"primate possessed in this state shall not be bred.

(2) A primate on the endangered species list may be bred only
by:

(A) An institution accredited by or certified by the
American Zoo and Aquarium Association; or

(B) A facility or person that holds a current signed
memorandum of participation with an Association of Zoos and Aquariums species
survival plan."

AND

Page 6, line 32, add the following:

"20-19-609. Exemptions.

This subchapter does not apply to:

(1) An institution accredited by the American Zoo and Aquarium
Association or under mentorship through the American Zoo and Aquarium
Association;

(2) An incorporated nonprofit animal protection organization
housing a wild and exotic animal at the written request of a law enforcement
agency;

(3) A law enforcement agency or officer acting under this
subchapter;

(4)(A) A person who is licensed by the Arkansas State Game and
Fish Commission to rehabilitate native wildlife.

(B) A person is exempt under subdivision (4)(A) of this
section only for the native wildlife that the person possesses;



(5) A licensed veterinary hospital or clinic treating wild and exotic animals; or

(6) A wildlife sanctuary."
