Amend House Bill No. 1350 as engrossed, H2/20/13 (version: 02/20/2013 10:17:02 AM):

Page 2, delete lines 18 through 27 and substitute:

"(b)(1) No less than $\frac{1}{2}$ thirty (30) days before the discharge date, the Department of Community Correction shall submit notice to:

- (A) The prosecuting attorney; and
- (B) The Parole Board.
- (2) Within thirty (30) fourteen (14) days before the discharge date, the prosecuting attorney or the Parole Board may file a petition in the sentencing court stating any reasonable objection to early discharge under this subchapter warranting the forfeiture of earned-discharge credit."
