Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 1785

Amend House Bill No. 1785 as originally introduced:

Page 2, line 23, delete "<u>standardized tests and</u>" and substitute "<u>standardized tests or</u>"

AND

Page 3, delete lines 16 through 20

AND

Page 3, line 23, delete "(a)" and substitute "(a)(1)(A)"

AND

Page 3, line 22, delete "Digital" and substitute "Pilot program - Digital"

AND

Page 3, line 24, delete "<u>charter schools shall</u>" and substitute "<u>charter</u> <u>schools participating in a pilot program shall</u>"

AND

Page 3, line 25, delete "courses" and substitute "course"

AND

Page 3, delete line 26 and substitute:

"<u>method of instruction.</u> <u>(B)</u> The Department of Education shall adopt rules to implement the pilot program, the purpose of which shall be to more smoothly implement the requirements under subdivision (a)(2) of this section.

(2) Beginning in the 2014-2015 school year, all public school districts and public charter schools shall provide at least one (1) digital

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<u>learning course to their students as either a primary or supplementary method</u> of instruction."

AND

Page 3, line 33, delete "<u>individual</u>" and substitute "<u>participating</u>"

AND

Page 3, line 36, delete "tests and local" and substitute "tests or local"

AND

Page 4, delete lines 4 through 6 and substitute:

"(e) The State Board of Education shall not limit the number of digital learning courses for which a student may receive credit through a public school or a public charter school and shall ensure that digital learning courses may be used as both primary and secondary methods of instruction."
