Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 1789
Amend House Bill No. 1789 as originally introduced:
Page 2, delete lines 23 through 25 and substitute: "(e) The principal of the resident school shall permit a home-schooled student to pursue participation in an interscholastic activity of the resident school if the student or the student's parent: (1) Before the signup, tryout, or participation deadlines
established for students enrolled in the resident school, provides to the principal a notice of the student's desire to pursue participation; and (2) Informs the principal in the notice that the student has demonstrated academic eligibility by obtaining:
(A) A minimum test score of the thirtieth percentile on a nationally recognized norm-referenced test in the previous twelve (12)
months;
(B) A minimum score on a test approved by the State Board of Education; or
(C) A minimum score on a test approved by the Arkansas
Activities Association."
AND
Page 2, delete line 35 and 36 and substitute: "(B) Standards of behavior and codes of conduct; and (C) The academic criteria under subdivision (e)(2) of this
section;"
AND
Page 3, delete lines 1 through 9
AND
Page 3, delete line 17 and substitute: "district; (2) Paraired to be at school not now than and (1) paraired now
(2) Required to be at school not more than one (1) period per school day if necessary for insurance purposes; and"

Page 3, line 18, delete " $\underline{(2)}$ " and substitute " $\underline{(3)}$ "
