Subtitle of House Bill No. 1789

TO ALLOW HOME-SCHOOLED STUDENTS TO PARTICIPATE IN INTERSCHOLASTIC ACTIVITIES.

Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 1789

Amend House Bill No. 1789 as originally introduced:

Page 2, delete lines 23 through 25 and substitute:

"(e) The principal of the resident school shall permit a home-schooled student to pursue participation in an interscholastic activity of the resident school if the student or the student's parent:

(1) Before the signup, tryout, or participation deadlines established for students enrolled in the resident school, provides to the principal a notice of the student's desire to pursue participation; and

(2) Informs the principal in the notice that the student has demonstrated academic eligibility by obtaining:

(A) A minimum test score of the thirtieth percentile on a nationally recognized norm-referenced test in the previous twelve (12) months;

(B) A minimum score on a test approved by the State Board of Education; or

(C) A minimum score on a test approved by the Arkansas Activities Association."

AND

Page 2, delete line 35 and 36 and substitute:

"(B) Standards of behavior and codes of conduct; and

(C) The academic criteria under subdivision (e)(2) of this section;"

AND

Page 3, delete lines 1 through 9

AND

Page 3, delete line 17 and substitute:

"district;

(2) Required to be at school not more than one (1) period per school day if necessary for insurance purposes; and"



AND

Page 3, line 18, delete "(2)" and substitute "(3)"
