**Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill No. 1133**

Amend Senate Bill No. 1133 as originally introduced:

Page 2, delete lines 2 through 9 and substitute:

"5-65-122. Driving while intoxicated - Sixth or subsequent offense.  
(a) A sixth of subsequent offense of violating § 5-65-103 occurring  
within ten (10) years of a prior offense is a Class B felony.  
(b) The following are considered a prior offense for purposes of  
subsection (a) of this section:  
(1) A prior conviction for violation of a penal law of another  
state, federal, or foreign jurisdiction that is equivalent to § 5-65-103; or  
(2) A prior conviction for violation of § 5-10-105(a)(1)(A) or  
(B)."
