Amendment No. 5 to Senate Bill No. 607

Amend Senate Bill No. 607 as engrossed, S4/3/13 (version: 04/03/2013 8:51:06 AM):

Page 1, delete lines 8 through 11 and substitute "AN ACT CONCERNING
ELECTRONIC PAYMENT TRANSACTIONS UNDER THE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES LAW; TO DECLARE
AND EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

AND

Delete the subtitle in its entirety and substitute:

"AN ACT CONCERNING ELECTRONIC PAYMENT
TRANSACTIONS UNDER THE ALCOHOLIC
BEVERAGES LAW AND TO DECLARE AND
EMERGENCY."

AND

Delete SECTION 1 of the bill

AND

Page 4, delete lines 18 through 30 and substitute: "General Assembly of the
State of Arkansas that retailers are at a disadvantage in the method allowed
for purchasing alcoholic beverages from wholesalers; that this disadvantage
significantly impacts their immediate operation of business; and that
allowing the use of electronic payments for the purchase of alcoholic
beverages from wholesalers will serve all citizens of the State of Arkansas.
Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and this act"
