## Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill No. 830

Amend Senate Bill No. 830 as originally introduced:

Page 1, delete line 32 and substitute the following:

"SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 15-42-104(d)(1)(A)(ii) is repealed.

(ii) A totally disabled military veteran for a onetime fee of thirty-five dollars and fifty cents (\$35.50);

- SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 15-42-104(d)(2), concerning special fees for resident hunting and fishing licenses, is amended to read as follows:
- (2) The commission shall offer a resident issued a lifetime hunting and fishing license under subdivision (d)(l)(A) of this section,  $\Theta$  a hunting-only license or a fishing-only license under subdivision (d)(l)(B) of this section, or a hunting license or a fishing license issued under § 15-42-128:
- (A) A lifetime trout stamp for a one-time fee of five dollars (\$5.00);
- (B) A lifetime state duck stamp for a one-time fee of seven dollars (\$7.00); or
- (C) Both a lifetime trout stamp and a lifetime state duck stamp for a one-time fee of twelve dollars (\$12.00).
- SECTION 3. Arkansas Code  $\S$  15-42-104(e)(1), concerning special fees for resident hunting and fishing licenses, is amended to read as follows:
- (1) Define "military veteran", "resident", and "totally disabled"; and
  - SECTION 4. Arkansas Code Title 15, Chapter 42, Subchapter 1, is"
