Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill No. 973

Amend Senate Bill No. 973 as originally introduced:

Delete everything after the enacting clause and substitute:

"SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 12-10-318(c)(1), concerning emergency telephone service charges, is amended to read as follows: (c)(1) There is established the Arkansas Emergency Telephone Services Board, consisting of the following: (A) The Auditor of State or his or her designated representative; (B) Two (2) representatives selected by a majority of the commercial mobile radio service providers licensed to do business in the state; and Two (2) 911 system employees selected by a majority of (C) the public safety answering point administrators in the state; (D) The Director of the Arkansas Department of Emergency Management or the director's designee; (E) One (1) consumer member to be appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate; and (F) One (1) consumer member to be appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives."
