## Subtitle of House Bill No. 1787

LIMITING THE LIABILITY OF A LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY FOR ACTS COMMITTED BY A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER IN THE AGENCY'S EMPLOYMENT WHILE THE OFFICER IS WORKING FOR A THIRD PARTY OUTSIDE OF HIS OR HER NORMAL WORKING HOURS.

## Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 1787

Amend House Bill No. 1787 as originally introduced:

Delete everything after the enacting clause and substitute the following: "SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 16, Chapter 120, Subchapter 1, is amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

<u>16-120-106. Limitation of liability for local law enforcement</u>

agencies.

A local law enforcement agency has tort immunity for any act by an employee of the local law enforcement agency who is a certified law enforcement officer that occurs while the employee is working for a third party outside of the:

(1) Employee's normal working hours; or

(2) Scope of the employee's employment with the local law enforcement agency."
