## Subtitle of House Bill No. 1391

TO AMEND THE ARKANSAS MEDICAL MARIJUANA AMENDMENT OF 2016 REGARDING LOCAL REGULATIONS; AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY.

## Amendment No. 1 to House Bill No. 1391

Amend House Bill No. 1391 as originally introduced:

Delete SECTION 1 in its entirety and substitute the following:

"SECTION 1. Pursuant to § 23 of Arkansas Constitution, Amendment 98, also known as the "Arkansas Medical Marijuana Amendment of 2016", Arkansas Constitution, Amendment 98, § 14, is amended to read as follows:

§ 14. Local regulation.

(a) This amendment does not prohibit a city, incorporated town, or county of this state from enacting reasonable zoning regulations applicable to dispensaries, <del>or</del> cultivation facilities, <u>or any other licensed marijuana</u> <u>facility</u> provided that those zoning regulations are the same as those for a licensed retail pharmacy.

(b) This section does not allow allows a city, incorporated town, or county to:

(1) Regulate or prohibit the operation of any dispensaries, or cultivation facilities, or any other licensed marijuana facility in the city, incorporated town, or county unless such a prohibition is approved at by an election under Article 5, § 1, of this constitution; or

(2) Regulate the operation of any dispensaries, cultivation facilities, or any other licensed marijuana facilities in the city, incorporated town, or county by a majority vote of a city council or county guorum court."
