"(b)(1) Regardless of whether the healthcare professional is
compensated for the healthcare services, if a healthcare professional seeks
to provide healthcare services to a minor through telemedicine in a school
setting and the minor is enrolled in the Arkansas Medicaid Program, the
healthcare professional shall:
(A) Be the designated primary care provider of the minor;
(B) Have a cross-coverage arrangement with the designated
primary care provider of the minor; or
(C) Have authorization from the designated primary care
provider of the minor.
(2) If the minor does not have a designated primary care
provider, subdivision (b)(1) of this section does not apply.
(3) If a minor is enrolled in a health benefit plan as defined
in § 23-79-1601 that is not part of the Arkansas Medicaid Program, the terms
and conditions of the health benefit plan shall control. (4) The designation of a primary care provider for a minor
remains the right of a parent or legal guardian in accordance with § 20-9-60]
