Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill No. 442
Amend Senate Bill No. 442 as originally introduced:
Page 1, delete lines 27 through 29, and substitute the following: "(b) A public school building is exempt from taxation under Arkansas
Constitution, Article 16, § 5, whether the public school building is: (1) Owned by a public school district or an open-enrollment
public charter school; (2) Leased by a public school district or an open-enrollment
public charter school on a lease-purchase agreement; or (3)(A) Leased by a public school district or an open-enrollment
<u>public charter school on any other lease agreement for an amount below fair</u> <u>market value.</u>
(B) In order to be exempt from taxation under subdivision (b)(3)(A) of this section, a lessor shall present evidence to the county
assessor that:
(i) The lease agreement is for an amount below fair market value; and
(ii) The difference between the amount of the lease
agreement and fair market value is equal to or greater than the amount that
would have been collected in taxes on the public school building if the
public school building had not been exempt from taxation under this section.
(C) If the county assessor determines that the lease
agreement does not meet the requirements of subdivision (b)(3)(B) of this section, the lessor may appeal the determination to the circuit court."
