Amendment No. 1 to House Bill 1120

Amend House Bill No. 1120 as originally introduced:

Add Joint Budget Committee as a cosponsor of the bill

Page 11, immediately following SECTION 21, insert a new SECTION to read as follows:

- " SECTION 22. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. CODE AMENDMENT. Arkansas Code Title 20, Chapter 77, Subchapter 9, is amended to add an additional section to read as follows:
 - 20-77-912. Funds for investigations and prosecutions.
- (a) Under this subchapter and the Medicaid Fraud Act, § 5-55-101 et seq., the Attorney General or a prosecuting attorney is entitled to recover reasonable and necessary expenses incurred during its investigations and prosecutions.
- (b) The Attorney General shall create and maintain accounts for these funds.
- (c) The federal share of these funds shall be returned to the United States Government in accordance with the federal regulations governing the Medicaid Fraud Control Unit.
- (d) The remaining funds shall be retained and expended by the Attorney General to defer the cost of future investigations and prosecutions conducted by the Medicaid Fraud Control Unit."
