Page 3, delete lines 3 through 5, and substitute the following: "(E)(i) A public elementary school may seek a waiver from
the requirements under subdivision (a)(5) if the public elementary school:
(a) Submits to the Department of Education for approval an alternative plan for recess that:
(1) Exceeds the required minimum amount
of minutes combined for physical activity under § 6-16-132 and recess under
this section; and
(2) Provides for both structured and
unstructured social time; or
(b) Is approved by the department to operate as a virtual school.
(ii) Beginning with the 2019-2020 school year, the
department shall provide to the House Committee on Education and the Senate
Committee on Education each year for three (3) years a report that details
the following:
(a) Which public elementary schools have been
granted a waiver under subdivision (a)(5)(E)(i) of this section; and
(b) How many waivers have been granted by the department under subdivision (a)(5)(E)(i) of this section."
