Amendment No. 1 to House Bill 1837

Amend House Bill No. 1837 as originally introduced:

Page 2, delete lines 28 and 29, and substitute the following: "actuarial principles;"

AND

Page 3, delete line 5, and substitute the following: "are not inconsistent with 29 C.F.R. § 2510, as it existed on January 1, 2019.

(d)(1) To the extent permitted by federal law, a fully insured or self-insured multiple employer welfare arrangement may include employers in a common trade or industry, employers representing two (2) or more trades or industries, sole proprietors, or working owners as defined in 29 C.F.R. § 2510.3-5(e), as it existed on January 1, 2019.

(2) The rules by which the multiple employer welfare arrangement shall abide are determined at the aggregate level so in an arrangement in which the total number of employers in the multiple employer welfare arrangement, including working owners, exceeds fifty (50), the multiple employer welfare arrangement is subject to the requirements of the large group market."
