Subtitle of Senate Bill No. 115

TO PROVIDE EXCEPTIONS TO THE MINIMUM WAGE LAW FOR INDIVIDUALS UNDER EIGHTEEN, EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS, EMPLOYERS WITH FEWER THAN FIFTY EMPLOYEES, AND NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS AND TO AMEND THE LAW IMPACTING INITIATED ACT 5 OF 2018.

Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill 115

Amend Senate Bill No. 115 as originally introduced:

Page 1, line 15, delete "2018" and substitute "2018; TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY" AND

Delete the subtitle in its entirety and substitute:

"TO PROVIDE EXCEPTIONS TO THE MINIMUM WAGE LAW; TO AMEND THE LAW IMPACTING INITIATED ACT 5 OF 2018; AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY."

AND

Page 2, line 5, delete "four (4)" and substitute "four (4) fifty (50)"

AND

Page 2, line 15, delete "education;" and substitute "education; or"

AND

Page 2, delete lines 16 through 18

AND

Page 2, line 19, delete "(iv)" and substitute "(iii)"

AND



Immediately following SECTION 2, add an additional section to read as follows:

"SECTION 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that delay in implementation of this act would cause disruption in the business market and that a need exists for consistency in the implementation of the Minimum Wage Act of the State of Arkansas, § 11-4-201 et seq. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become effective on:

- (1) The date of its approval by the Governor;
- (2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill; or
- (3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto."
