## Amendment No. 3 to Senate Bill 179

Amend Senate Bill No. 179 as engrossed, S2/11/19 (version: 02/11/2019 9:33:27 AM)

Immediately before SECTION 1 of the bill, add the following:
 "SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 14-43-303(a), concerning officials in
mayor-council cities of 50,000 or more, is amended to add an additional
subdivision to read as follows:

(3) The governing body of a city in transition to the mayor-council form of government may provide by ordinance that the mayor, city clerk, city attorney, and city treasurer shall be elected on the same date and every four (4) years thereafter."

Page 1, line 26, delete "by the electors under" and substitute "by the board of directors by ordinance. It shall be signed by electors equal in number to fifteen percent (15%) of the aggregate number of ballots cast for the position of mayor in the immediately preceding mayoral general election."

- (A) A person who is on the ballot in 2020 to become a member of the city council shall serve a term of two (2) years if elected;
- (B) Following the 2020 federal decennial census, the county board of election commissioners shall divide the city into six (6) wards having substantially equal population; and
- (C)(i) At the 2022 general election, two (2) city council members shall be elected from each of the six (6) wards, for a total number of twelve (12) city council members.
- (ii) The newly elected city council members shall draw initial two-year or four-year terms to result in staggered four-year terms."
