Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill 276

Amend Senate Bill No. 276 as originally introduced:

Add Representative G. Hodges as a cosponsor of the bill

AND

Page 1, delete lines 11 and 12, and substitute the following: "CANDIDATE FOR A PRIMARY ELECTION; TO AMEND THE TIME FOR THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY TO MEET IN FISCAL SESSION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES."

AND

Page 1, delete lines 18 through 20, and substitute the following: "PREFERENTIAL PRIMARY ELECTION; AND TO AMEND THE TIME FOR THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY TO MEET IN FISCAL SESSION."

AND

- Page 1, delete lines 28 through 32, and substitute the following:
- "(a) The general primary election shall be held on the $\frac{\text{third}}{\text{the general}}$ Tuesday in June preceding the general four (4) weeks following the preferential primary election.
- (b) The preferential primary election shall be held on the $\frac{\text{first}}{\text{Tuesday four (4)}}$ weeks before the general primary election after the first Monday in March."

AND

Page 3, delete line 23, and substitute the following: "county.



- SECTION 4. Arkansas Code § 10-2-101(b)(1), concerning the timing of the fiscal session of the General Assembly, is amended to read as follows: (b)(1) The General Assembly shall meet in a fiscal session at 12:00 noon on the second Monday in February Wednesday in April of each evennumbered year to consider appropriation bills.
- SECTION 5. Arkansas Code § 10-2-112(a)(1)(B)(i), concerning the prefiling of bills and resolutions, is amended to read as follows:

 (B)(i) The second Monday of January March of each year of a fiscal session of the General Assembly.
- SECTION 6. Arkansas Code § 10-3-2104(d)(3), concerning findings and recommendations of the House Committee on Education and Senate Committee on Education, is amended to read as follows:
- (3) By November March 1 of the calendar year before the beginning of a fiscal session, if the House Committee on Education and the Senate Committee on Education find that the recommendations in the most recent adequacy evaluation report filed under this section should be amended, the House Committee on Education and the Senate Committee on Education, jointly or separately, or both, shall advise in writing the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives of their findings and amendments to the adequacy evaluation report."

Page 3, line 25, delete "SECTION 4." and substitute "SECTION 7."

AND

Page 3, delete line 33, and substitute the following: "municipal offices for the forthcoming year.

SECTION 8. Arkansas Code § 19-4-304(b)(1), concerning the submission of the annual revenue forecast to the Legislative Council by the Director of the Department of Finance and Administration, is amended to read as follows:

(1) By $\frac{\text{December February}}{\text{February}}$ 1 of the year preceding a fiscal session; and"
