"plus a professional dispensing fee per dispensing"

Page 9, line 8, delete "(5) Pay" and substitute "(5)(A) Pay"

Page 9, line 11, delete "services;" and substitute "services."

Page 9, delete line 12, and substitute the following:

"(B)(i) The Arkansas Employee Benefits Division community pharmacy reimbursement model for pharmacist services in partnership with the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences based prescription drug program satisfies the intent of this subdivision.

(ii) A plan using the model described in subdivision (b)(5)(B)(i) of this section is exempt from complying with subdivision (b)(5)(A) of this section if the reimbursement model is maintained as determined by the Insurance Commissioner.

(iii) If a plan deviates from this reimbursement model, the plan shall be subject to subdivision (b)(5)(A) of this section; or"
