## Amendment No. 1 to Senate Bill 93

Amend Senate Bill No. 93 as originally introduced:

Page 3, delete line 6 in its entirety and substitute the following:

" (E) DATA PROC. 0

(05) STATEWIDE SCHOLARSHIP AND GRANT PROMOTION

295,000"

AND

Page 3, line 7 delete "\_\_\_\$4,092,860" and substitute "\_\_\_\$4,387,860"

AND

Page 6, line 8 delete "VETERINARY AID - LOANS" and substitute "VETERINARY MED. LOAN FORGIVENESS PROGRAM"

AND

Insert an additional SECTION immediately following SECTION 40 to read as follows:

"SECTION 41. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. STATEWIDE SCHOLARSHIP AND GRANT PROMOTION. Of the general revenue that is received by and distributed from the Higher Education Grants Fund Account, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall transfer two hundred ninety-five thousand dollars (\$295,000) to the Department of Higher Education Fund Account to be allocated, budgeted, committed and distributed to the Statewide Scholarship and Grant Promotion line item in the General Operations section of this act for the purpose of increasing public awareness of the scholarships and grants offered by the State through the Arkansas Department of Higher Education. The Department shall utilize a minimum of one hundred forty-seven five hundred



dollars (\$147,500) of the aforementioned total specifically for the promotic	n
of the Arkansas Futures Grant Program.	
The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2019	)
through June 30, 2020."	-
