- $\sqrt{\rm ALE}$, ELL & PD Categoricals are increased 1.8% each fiscal year.

ADDITIONAL COMMENTS

√ NSLA funding will receive zero increase each fiscal year and be held at the current level of funding per eligible student; any funding increases will be associated with greater eligibility and participation rates.
