Bill: SB320 Bill Subtitle: TO REQUIRE THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND ADMINISTRATION TO ANNUALLY REPORT ON THE ACTIVITIES OF THE MULTISTATE TAX COMMISSION; AND TO ELIMINATE THE MULTISTATE TAX COMPACT ADVISORY COMMITTEE.

Basic Change : Sponsor: Sen. Maloch

SB320 eliminates the requirement for the MTC Advisory Committee to meet annually and instead requires DFA to file an annual report with the General Assembly on the activities of the MTC and Arkansas' involvement. The state of Arkansas became a member of the Multistate Tax Compact in 1967. At that time a state law was enacted creating the MTC Advisory Committee to monitor the activities of the Commission.
