I) AGENCY SUMMARY & REVENUE SOURCES:

MISSION

The Auctioneer's Licensing Board regulates auctioneers and auction house owners and imposes penalties against those persons committing wrongful acts against the public. The board administers licenses, examinations, and renewals. The board currently oversees more than 850 licensed auctioneers and auction house owners.

TOTAL APPROPRIATION

The total appropriation is \$211,606.

FUNDING SOURCE

The Board is a cash agency funded from the receipt of fees generated by examinations, licensing fees, renewals, and penalties.
